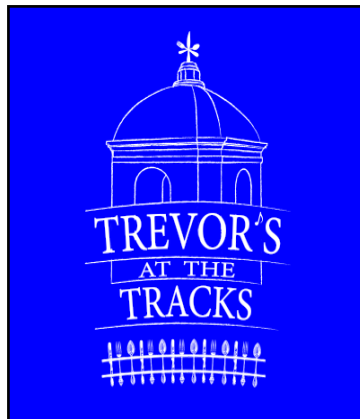

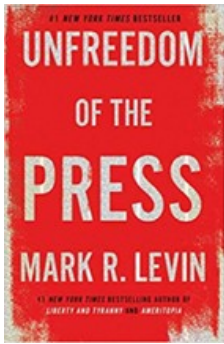


### Book Club Review

### *Unfreedom of the Press* by Mark Levin

★★★★★ (4.75 Stars)

Mark Levin's *Unfreedom of the Press* details how the very people and institutions entrusted with objectively informing the public have devolved the once-honorable profession of journalism into its current state as an oppressive, biased propaganda machine.



Unlike early American publishers whose pamphlets and newspapers championed the ideals referred to in our Declaration of Independence and Constitution, today's press is largely bent on eradicating our hard-earned freedoms, enforcing uniformity of thought, and championing progressive ideals (and encouraging those who wish to bring about such ideals to do so by any means necessary). Indeed, Levin cautions in his introduction that "[w]hen the media function as a propaganda tool for a single political party and ideology, they not only destroy their own purpose but threaten the existence of a free republic."

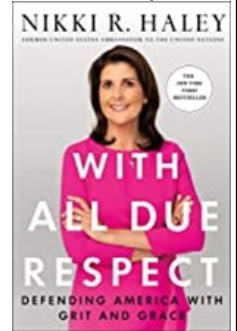
*Unfreedom of the Press* traces the history of the press in the United States, providing clear evidence of the media censoring and/or suppressing information, crossing the line between reporting and activism, and marginalizing the citizenry they claim to serve.

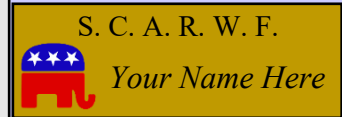

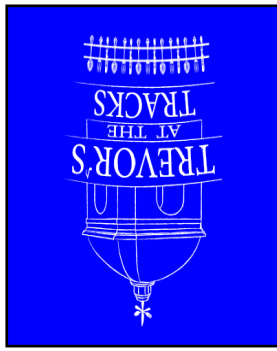
