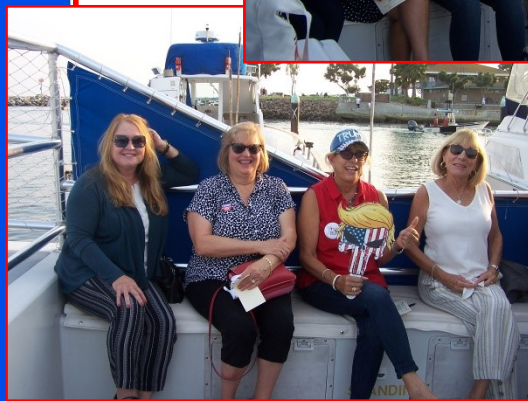

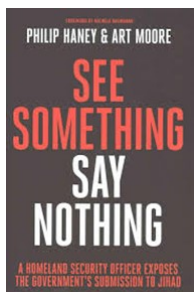
Book Club Review

See Something, Say Nothing by Philip Haney



Rating—4.25/5 stars

Philip Haney's *See Something, Say Nothing* is an extremely well-documented exposé of how our own government has allowed and even welcomed a pervasive Islamic jihadi influence on U.S. counterterrorism policies, muting the effectiveness of our homeland security forces and endangering the lives of American citizens.



Haney begins by reminding readers that frontline Department of Homeland Security (DHS) officers' primary duty is "trying to stop people who pose a threat to the nation's security from entering through more than 350 air, land, and seaports across the country." After the 9/11 attack by terrorists motivated by a literal belief in and an active adherence to establishing Islamic sharia law in the U.S. as the law of our land, the DHS was formed. Yet as a member of Customs and Border Patrol (CBP) and a founding member of the Department of Homeland Security, Haney faced opposition as he sought to enforce the core values of the CBP. At the end of the Bush administration and throughout the Obama administration, the DHS emphasis on protecting American lives shifted to protecting the civil rights and civil liberties of foreign nationals, making Haney's job and the jobs of others involved in securing our borders infinitesimally harder. This policy known as "Countering Violent Extremism (CVE)," barred the use of intelligence based on religious affiliation, as well as the use of the words Islam, terrorist, or terms drawn from Islamic theology such as caliphate, wahhabist, ummah, etc., and as President Obama made clear in his 2009 speech "A New Beginning" in Cairo, Egypt, at Al-Azhar University, the CVE completely overturned the initial post-9/11 law enforcement-based counterterrorism policy.

Throughout his tenure at DHS, Haney was investigated nine times and ordered to delete more than 800 records concerning individuals associated with Muslim Brotherhood front groups in the U.S. who had proven links to the Palestinian terrorist organization Hamas. Yet had Haney's warnings been heeded, innocent Americans might have been saved from the San Bernardino and other tragedies. An apt review notes, "The national campaign by the DHS to raise public awareness of terrorism and terrorism-related crime known as 'If You See Something, Say Something' effectively has become 'If You See Something, Say Nothing.'"

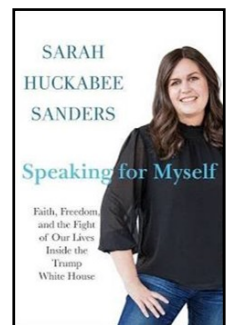

Orange County, CA Elections Releases Election Observer Guidelines Under COVID-19

Election observation materials and an online training will be provided to the public in advance of the November 3, 2020 Presidential General Election.

SANTA ANA, CA – September 25, 2020 – Each election in Orange County, the Orange County Registrar of Voters invites members of the public to observe the election process. Election observers are permitted to observe Vote Center operations, including opening and closing procedures, view all activities at the central counting site, view mail ballot and provisional ballot processing, and much more.

As a result of COVID-19 impacting election operations, the Orange County Registrar of Voters is taking several steps to provide updated information on how election observation can be conducted safely to the public.

[The November 2020 Election Observer Guidelines Handbook is now available in the Orange County Registrar of Voters' online Election Library.](#) The Handbook details election observation guidelines at Vote Centers and how to observe ballot processing both in-person and remotely.

[Beginning October 1, 2020, members of the public may apply online to observe ballot processing remotely, and access an online training tool at \[ocvote.com/observe\]\(https://ocvote.com/observe\).](#) Upon approval, individuals will be able to select what processes to view; however, certain processes will only be available for viewing at specific times when it is active. Opportunities to observe remotely will begin on October 7, 2020.

Quote by Registrar of Voters Neal Kelley:

"My team and I are committed to ensuring that voting and elections are conducted in an open and transparent manner with integrity that increases the public's trust and confidence in elections in Orange County, even under COVID-19". He continued, "These materials and trainings are offered to the public in advance so they are aware of what is permitted by law and how they can prepare ahead of time if they plan to observe election and voting procedures."

All voters will receive a ballot through the mail for the November 3, 2020 Presidential General Election and all voters can check their registration, re-register, and register to vote at ocvote.com. [For more information, call 714-567-7600 or visit \[ocvote.com\]\(https://ocvote.com\).](#)

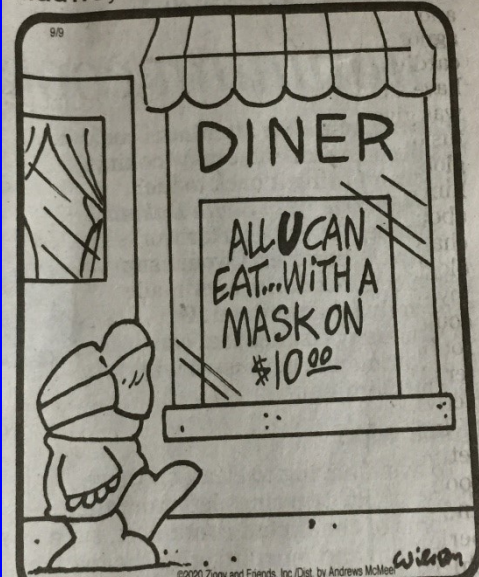

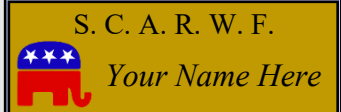
