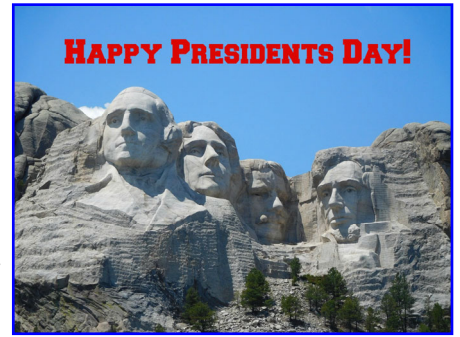

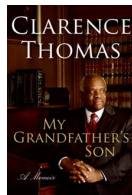

### Book Report

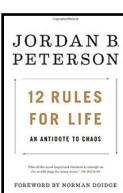
On Wednesday, January 16th, Book Club members met at Panera Bread Restaurant at 4 p.m. to discuss our latest book choice: Clarence Thomas, *My Grandfather's Son*. Though the Copyright is 2007, there is no doubt that this was a timely selection. Many of us witnessed the recent Confirmation Hearings of Justice Kavanaugh with disbelief, but this book underlines the messiness and extent to which the left will go to destroy a Republican candidate to the Supreme Court. Having read the life struggles of Clarence Thomas, his insights to his confirmation hearings caused this reader to again relive some of the left's nasty tactics. 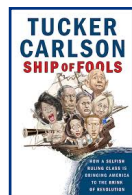
