



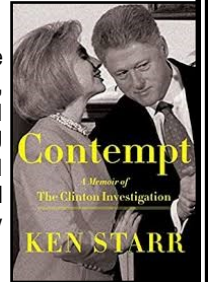

Author: **Ken Starr**

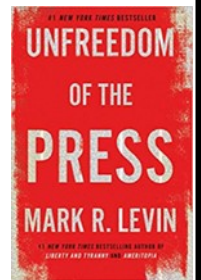

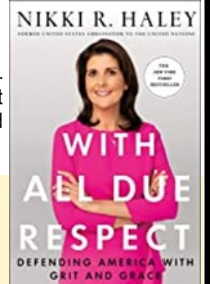

# Kelene Johnson

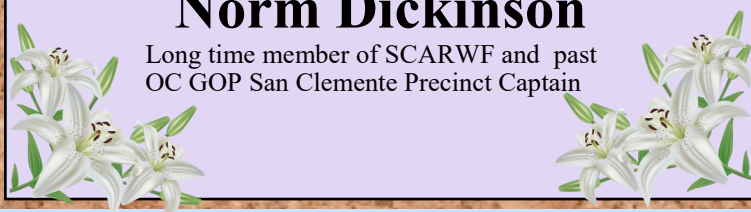

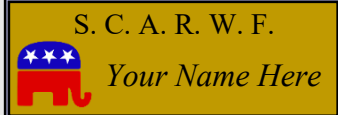
