## President's Message June, 2020

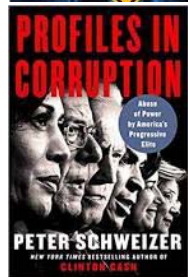
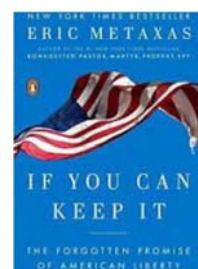
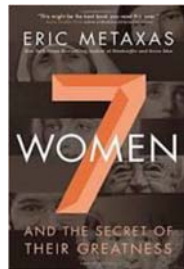
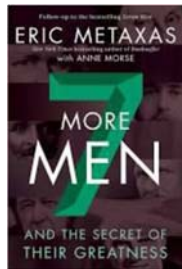
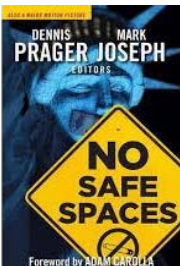
## Future Possibilities
