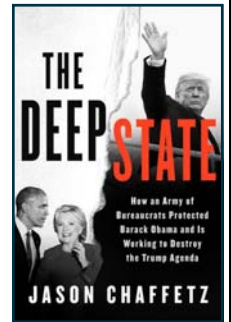

The next 3 books that we are reading include: HAPPINESS IS A SERIOUS PROBLEM, by Dennis Praeger, THE CASE AGAINST IMPEACHING TRUMP, by Alan Dershowitz, and MY GRANDFATHER'S SON, A MEMOIR, by Clarence Thomas. BOOK REPORT

On September 19th meeting at the Panera Restaurant at the San Clemente Outlets we discussed A VOICE FOR AMBASSADOR J. CHRISTOPHER STEVENS, by Lydie M. Denier. Those of you that were at the May, 2018 luncheon, may remember Lydie's presentation regarding her love and engagement to Chris Stevens, our United States Ambassador to Lybia who was murdered in Bengazi during the horrific events of September 11, 2012. Did you know that Chris was only four months into this assignment, and that he had spent over 30 years preparing for this work in Lybia? Chris' love of his assignments in the Foreign Service, and his commitment to the people of the Middle East, were loudly proclaimed in this book. Ms Denier brings light to his many talents and extraordinary courage and dedication to his work. Though Lydie and Chris were madly in love, their careers and differing backgrounds interfered in their final commitment to each other. The final pages of the book reveal Lydie's search for the truth regarding the circumstances of the ambassador's death. She concludes, as do most of us, that our Secretary of State, Hillary Clinton, hid the truth of these attacks from the American People to protect herself and the Obama Administration from political repercussions.

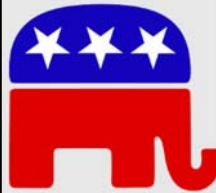
