**About our Speaker**  
**Shari Freidenrich**  
**Orange County Treasurer**

Shari Freidenrich was elected as Orange County Treasurer in 2010, was re-elected in June 2014 and June 2018, and ran unopposed in both 2014 and 2018. Shari is the first woman ever to be elected as the Orange County Treasurer and only the third woman elected in a Countywide race. Shari held the highest vote total of 451,081 in the ballots certified by the OC Registrar of voters in June 2018.

As Orange County Treasurer, Shari is responsible for overseeing a \$9 Billion investment portfolio, as a fiduciary and banker for both the County and School and Community District. She is also responsible for collecting all property taxes. Shari is an ex-officio member and the only female member of the 9- member Orange County Pension Board that manages the \$15 Billion Orange County employees' pension plan and a member of the Audit Oversight Committee, the Deferred Compensation Committee and the Public Financing Advisory Committee. In seven years, Shari has saved over \$871 million for Orange County Taxpayers. Shari is a national leader in the field of municipal treasury professionals. Shari is a past President of the California Municipal Treasurer's Association and a Past President for the Association of Public Treasurer's of the United States and Canada. She is currently serving as the Secretary for the California Association of County Treasurer Tax Collectors. In addition to being an active licensed CPA, Shari currently has four other state and national certifications designating her expertise in the field of public finance and funds management.

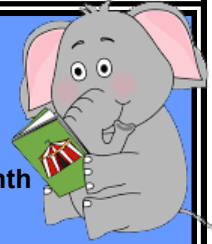
Shari is also a local leader in the financial field. Shari was instrumental in starting the first ever Financial Planning Day in Orange County, a nationwide event now held annually in over 20 cities. In 2013, Shari was awarded a "Rose Award" from the OC Taxpayer's Association for her work in streamlining property tax payments and saving taxpayer funds. She was also nominated for a Rose Award in 2016. She was honored in 2016 as an honorary member of the Orange County Association of Realtors for her work in transparency in Property taxes. Shari was the winner of the Leadership Award for Public Service in 2016 from the Orange County Business Council for her work in cutting red tape and providing red carpet service. Shari was selected in 2016 by the Orange County Business Journal in their inaugural OC 500, a list honoring the most influential individuals in Orange County as a governmental representative who has contributed to the community of business. She was also selected again in the 2018 OC 500 list. In 2018, Shari received the 2018 Trailblazer award and was selected as one of three "Experienced Women To Watch" by the California Society of CPAs. Finally, under Shari's leadership, the County of Orange received a 2018 National Association of Counties Achievement Award for being the first government agency nationally to implement a Medallion Signature Stamp program for official County business. Shari's office recently received a NACO achievement award as the 1st gov't agency qualifying for the Medallion Signature Guarantee Program.

She graduated summa cum laude from Washington State University with a Degree in Business and an emphasis in Accounting. She previously worked for Deloitte & Touche as an Audit manager, at Boeing Corporation as a Division Controller and at the City of Huntington Beach where she was the elected Treasurer for over 15 years where she was the first woman and CPA in this position.

Shari has been active in a number of organizations for over 20 years including being the President for both the Huntington Beach Rotary Club of HB and the Soroptimist Club of HB. She is a member of the Huntington Beach Chamber of Commerce and the South County Chamber of Commerce. Shari is also the Past President of the Alumni Association for Washington State University and currently serves on the Board of Directors for the Washington State University Foundation Board, where she is the past Audit Committee Chair. Shari and her husband, Clive, have lived in Orange County for 30 years.

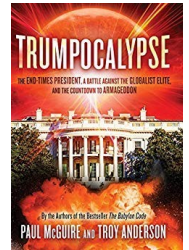

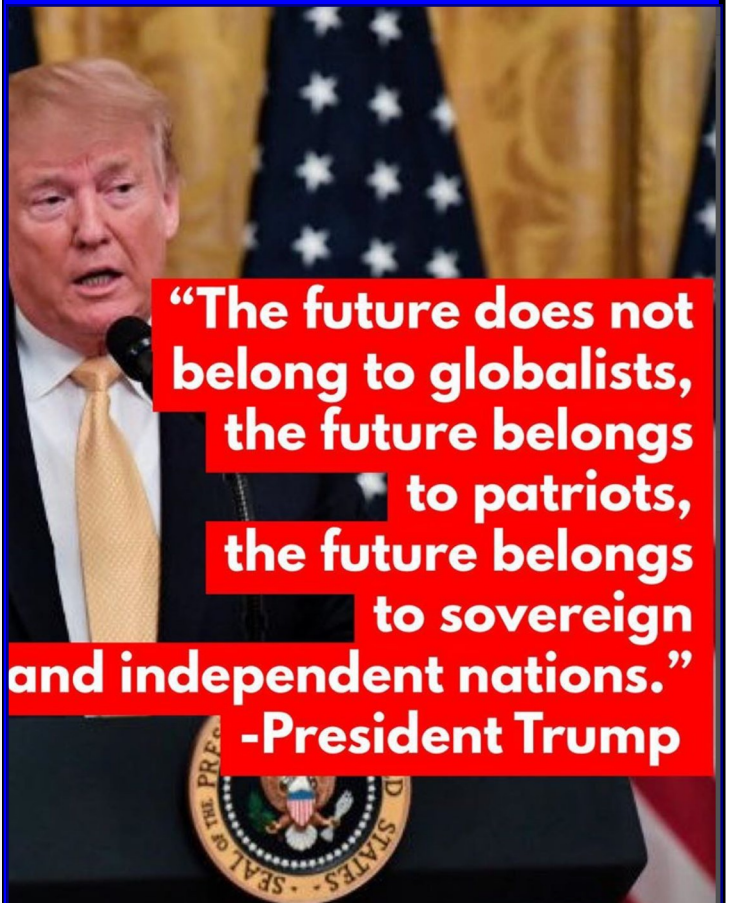

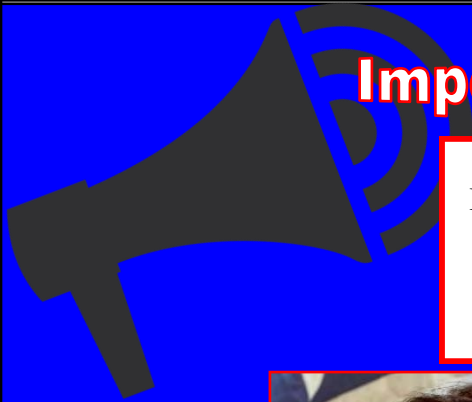

But my finest hour comes when I am torn in strips to be used as bandages for my wounded comrades on the field of battle - when I fly at half mast to honor my Soldiers, my Airman, my Sailors, my Marines, and - when I lie in the trembling arms of a grieving mother, at the graveside of her fallen son or daughter.

I am proud. My name is "Old Glory." Long may I wave, dear God, long may I wave."

# Women in History

## Women's National Republican Club Founder



## Henrietta Wells Livermore

(Excerpts from National Review—The Republican History of Women's Suffrage)

In New York State, the final push for suffrage was launched in 1910 by one-woman juggernaut Henrietta Wells Livermore, who also founded the Women's National Republican Club in 1921.

On February 14, 1910, twelve women met at Livermore's home to revitalize the suffrage movement in New York State, and suffrage for New York's women was passed in a statewide referendum in November 1917. To inform women of their newly gained right and the subjects they'd be voting on, she founded the Women's National Republican Club in New York City in 1921. Today, it's the oldest national club for Republican women in the country.

The clubhouse itself is the third home of the club, built to accommodate its growing membership, and is located in the heart of Manhattan at the site of Andrew Carnegie's former home at 3 West 51st Street. The building's interior is distinguished and regal, and it hosts gala dinners, awards ceremonies, and other events for its members. One of its committees is the Henrietta Wells Livermore School of Politics, which continues to organize volunteers for political campaigns and sponsors political-education seminars and lectures.

This year, to commemorate the historic achievement, the club is featuring an exhibit titled "Women's Suffrage and the Founding of The Women's National Republican Club" in its Manhattan headquarters. The exhibit highlights the suffrage movement, the club's role in educating women about politics and their newly gained right, and relics from the era, including a letter from President Calvin Coolidge.

"Livermore decided that women needed to be educated so they could vote," said Judy McGrath, the exhibit curator. "She was disappointed that there was very low female turnout in the first election that women could vote in, so she wanted to create a place where women could meet other women and become educated on the matters they'd be voting on."

Coolidge was an ardent supporter of suffrage at a time when it was unpopular. Usually a walker of the party line, he went against his party's orthodoxy, noting that women uniquely look to the future and "think of conditions not only for themselves but for their posterity."

**Eventually, the Republican party became the first major party to advocate equal rights for women, and it wasn't until the Republicans gained control of Congress in 1919 — after Democrats had defeated the 19th amendment four times — that the amendment passed. Twenty-six of the 36 states that ratified it had Republican legislatures.**

Our son, Mark, born in 1981, grew up in San Clemente and graduated from San Diego State University. His wife, Christina, is also a San Clemente native, and they live in San Clemente with their daughters Paisley, age 5, and Zoë, age 3. Life is good.

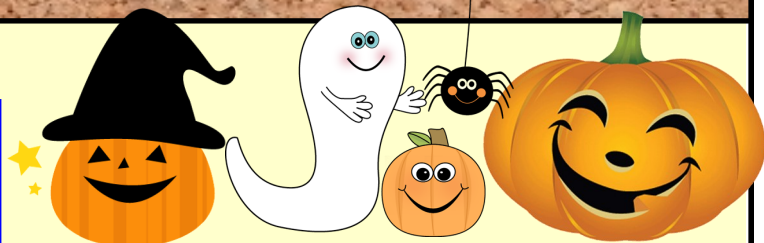
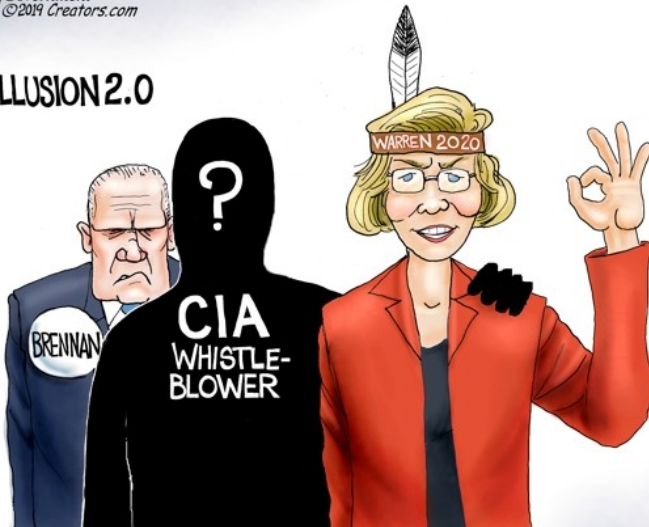

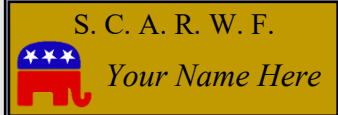
