Ruth's father was a U.S. History teacher, who taught using primary documents to instill a deep understanding of this country's real roots and purpose. As a result, she grew up with a healthy respect for America and everything that has made her exceptional.

As a Reagan Conservative and a Tea Party Member, she is proud to have attended the first 9-12 march on DC, the first National Tea Party Convention in Nashville, TN, the Glenn Beck American Revival training in Phoenix, and the Glenn Beck "Restoring Honor" event on the National Mall.

After retiring from 34 years of teaching high school English and Spanish, Ruth began to search for a new way of making a difference. She believes, as every American should, that voting in every election is the greatest privilege we have as American citizens, and the single most important act that we will ever do for ourselves and our posterity. 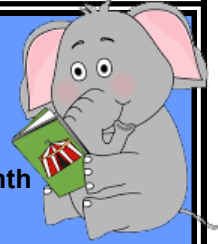

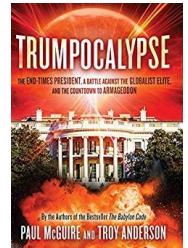

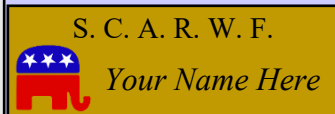
